MPs' expenses: my contract with you

I, Jack Lopresti, the Conservative candidate for Filton and Bradley Stoke, promise to:

- publish on my personal website details of all of my personal expenses incurred as your Member of Parliament
- publish on my personal website details of all of my office expenses incurred as your Member of Parliament
- publish on my personal website details of all donations of more than £1,000 to either Filton and Bradley Stoke Conservatives or to me, in line with Electoral Commission rules
- appoint a local firm of auditors to approve my expense accounts at the end of every financial year
- open up my unedited expenses claims to the local newspapers at the end of every financial year
- never claim for food
- never claim for furniture or household goods
- meet my own tax liabilities - such as stamp duty - without claiming them from the taxpayer
